Diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder at the age of 44, Special Education advocate **Carol Greenburg**'s understanding of disability is enhanced by the daily triumphs of her disabled son's struggles with spoken and written language. Carol helps families assess appropriate educational settings and services, and organizes paperwork for and attends IEP meetings with parents of children with a wide range of disabilities. Carol is an editor at Thinking Person's Guide to Autism book, blog, and online community.
