## The Scott J. Reisser Memorial Scholarship Fund The Making Headway Scholarship Fund

The Scott J. Reisser Memorial Scholarship fund is the culmination of his family's efforts to establish a fitting memorial for their beloved son, brother, grandson, nephew, and friend to so many. Scott's most cherished dream was to graduate from college, a milestone that he fell just short of achieving. After his death in 2006, it was clear that a vehicle to help other young brain tumor survivors achieve their educational goals was the most fitting memorial.

## **Eligibility for Application:**

- 1. Be a brain or spinal cord tumor survivor living in NY, NJ, or CT metropolitan area.
- 2. Attending or admitted to a 4- or 2-year college or vocational program.
- 3. Be a US citizen and/or a legal and permanent resident of the US.

## **Evaluation Criteria:**

- Financial hardship will be taken into consideration as a part of the selection process, but will not be the sole criteria. Demonstration of need can be accomplished by providing a copy of your Financial Aid Application (FAFSA – Free Application for Federal Student Aid), other Financial Aid Application or tax return. (See http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/ for more information.)
- 2. Academic Merit based on test scores, awards and other demonstrations of academic performance.
- 3. The candidate's ability and desire to overcome the challenges presented with a brain or spinal cord tumor diagnosis.
- 4. The personal statement by the student applicant will be evaluated as part of the application.
- 5. Letters of recommendation complete the application and are considered in the context of the entire application.
- 6. Copy of your most recent, full-year report card or transcript.
- 7. Documentation from the school confirming the total cost of the school year.
- 8. Priority will be given to those students who have not received scholarships in the past.
